

**I.D MACDONALD AUTOTEST CHAMPIONSHIP  
REGULATIONS 2006**

1. The Championship will consist of 3 rounds with all rounds counting towards the Championship. If for any reason less than 3 rounds are held then all rounds will count.
2. Dates and venues of all the rounds will be sent out with ASRs.
3. There will be 3 classes as follows: Class One – All cars up to 1400cc. Class Two – All cars 1401cc and over. Class Three – Specials (all capacities).  
There will be at least 4 tests with at least one run at each test per round. The fastest run at each test will count for the results. The number of runs and details of tests will be given on the day of the event.
4. Points will be awarded as follows:  
10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 to the fastest ten competitors in each class, plus one extra point for FTD.  
Ladies Award – Points will be awarded as above to the fastest ten female competitors overall. They are also eligible for overall and class awards.
5. Starting procedure will be electronic.
6. Stopping will be astride a line. Any competitor sliding through the finish line will receive a 20 second penalty. Other penalties will be applied as per current Blue Book.
7. The maximum entry per class is 20 and the minimum is 1.
8. All vehicles must comply with MSA vehicle regulations.
9. Chains, spiked or studded tyres or any other non-slip attachments will not be permitted.
10. No passengers will be carried during the tests.
11. If there is an average of ten or more competitors in any class for the year, an award for second in class will be made.
12. The entry fees will be as stated in the ASRs.
13. Entries will only be accepted from HCC Club members and members of invited clubs. Proof of club membership will be inspected as signing on.
14. Competition starts at 12.00hrs (or as stated in ASRs) and all competitors must have entries paid and signed on 15 minutes prior to the start of the first test.  
Vehicles must be scrutineered before competitors sign on.
15. A vehicle may be driven by up to two drivers but a driver may enter only one vehicle.  
Seat belts must be worn for the duration of the test.
16. All rounds in the Championship will count towards the I. C Smith Club Championship for HCC members only.
17. In the event of a tie for an award the tie will be resolved as follows: At the round of the Championship, the organisers will lay out a test involving driving through a line of bollards and returning to the finish line. Tying competitors will have one run in their own vehicle and one run in each of the tying vehicles, the winner being the competitor with the lowest penalty of all runs.
18. Awards will be presented at the Club's Annual Presentation of Awards as follows:  
1<sup>st</sup> overall – I.D MacDonald Trophy  
2<sup>nd</sup> overall – Hatze Trophy  
Perpetual awards will be presented to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> overall and to first in each class and first female.  
Overall winners are not eligible for class awards.
19. Stewards of the Championship will be the Honorary President and the Honorary Vice Presidents.
