Explanation

Both classes are given the same information, but in different formats.

Once the Novices have found the two spot heights, the route approaching SH115 from the north will also pass the required “m”, in Drumnagally. You then have to find and get to the B10, but on the way there you must avoid the “n” in Edenderry because it is not included in the instruction – see paragraph 3 of the Regs.

Once at the B10 you have to work out how to use the B10 three times before TC16. This means leaving and re-joining that road twice.

Unusually, the Experts are also given the control MR – the instruction has more than one solution without it, so you need to spot it.

But your first task is to spot that the two 3-figure spot heights have been divided into three 2-figure groups. The “m” should help to work that out.

After SH115 the eye should fall on the B10 road number quite quickly, though probably not until after looking for a “101”.

And remembering all the while to avoid the “n” in Edenderry.
