TC12 to TC13

Novice

CRO

('Y' = a wide yellow road, and 'y' = a narrow yellow road)

Expert

avoid spot heights

Explanation

CRO could have been YRO for this section!

Basically the same instruction for both classes. The groupings are the roads at consecutive junctions and the usual convention is that the first letter is the approach road, the last is the depart road, and the 'missed' roads are in the middle. The Novices have the control location and you just have to work through it, with the crossroads towards the end as reassurance that you are on the correct route.

Much the same for the Experts, most of whom will be familiar with the lower and upper case distinction, but which is nicely logical for those who are not. The 'avoid spot heights' is required to ensure you TR at the penultimate junction.
