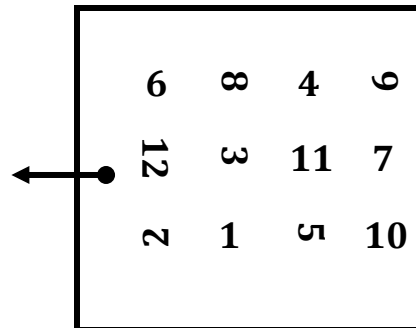
Enter each junction by the hour hand, and leave by the minute hand:-

Explanation

Some clock work for the Novices. The route instruction sheet had a bit of room where you could draw the clock face. But a shortcut which works here if all junctions are included is just to ignore the hour hand and think only about the minute hand, as the exit direction at consecutive junctions. You shouldn't have to draw that out!

The Expert's instruction builds on theirs for the previous section. The ball and arrow again indicates the grid square exit direction. But of course they cannot all be 'exit to the West' and it is the orientation of the numbers (consecutively numbered grid squares) which determines the GS exit direction.

So 1 is exit to the west, and 2 is exit to the north etc. By now, Experts will be looking out for numbers which have more than one way up, and a bit of trial and error will be necessary. At least one wrong route goes all the way to GS11 before breaking down.
