A list of map features for the Novices, some of which are underlined and therefore have to be avoided.

All is relatively straightforward (as long as you have spotted the avoids) until the first church. It is adjacent to the yellow road on which you approach it from the east, and you may decide to continue west to approach SH119 from the NE at the next junction. But according to the Regulations you do not pass the church on that route because the church symbol does not touch or break the edges of that road. So you have to turn left immediately before the church. Its symbol does break the edge of that road, and that leads to SH119 approaching from the SE.

From there you have to avoid a steep hill and GS2455, but pass through the remaining features (letters on the road, SH's and another church) on the way to TC49.

The Experts instruction looks like some arithmetic is required and, if you do the sums, the round number answers of 220 and 270 may suggest that is the correct approach. But it is quite simply four spotheights and two churches.

All other SH's have to be avoided. There is a second option for SH165 (in GS2456) but no way of using it to create a shorter route than via the 165 in GS 2555.

And it is shortest route which otherwise leads you to the correct route, as long as you have spotted the loop which is necessary (as explained above for the Novices) to pick up the church just before SH119.
