Letters on the road for both classes here. The Novices get a whole word with the crossed letter in bold, while the Experts just get the letters.

The Novices also have the TC location so the challenge is just to find the words and make a route through the required letters. That “cassock”, “breeze” and “Ball” are only part of the relevant words on the map may add to the challenge, but not too significantly. And remember to pick the shortest route on the approach to Kircassock.

The Experts’ challenge is a bit more tricky, as of course it should be. The “H” is sufficiently close to TC62 to be found quite quickly, but the absence of the TC63 location leaves a wide search for the other letters.

And the letters in Geehans Bridge in GS1256 fall tantalisingly close to those you are looking for. But the “n” in Geehans also falls on the road so your search should head elsewhere.

Of course finding the s, e and B is the task, but other letters also effectively block roads and therefore assist in narrowing the options and help to find the correct route. Once you have rejected the Geehans Bridge route, the only other available road leads you towards Kircassock.

And the “e” in Drumbreeze is sufficiently close to Kircassock to be found quite quickly.

And with Toughlumny and Gartross blocking other routes, Ballymagaraghan should reveal itself even though the “B” only just clips the road edge – and that is sufficient according to the regs.
