### LEG 2

TC16 to TC17

#### Novice

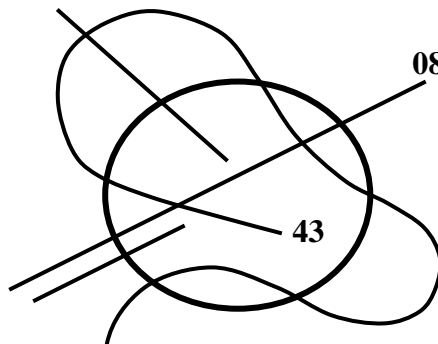
Cross GL 43 at

#### Explanation

4-figure numbers often mean a grid square, but not on this occasion for the Novices. Spot that GL43 is a northing, and that the eastings in the area are 07, 08 and 09 and this becomes quite easy. The 4-digit numbers are effectively the first half of 8-figure map references, all ending in 4300.

The Experts get a Spaghetti Hoop! It is grid lines crossing the circular road route.

Two of the grid lines are numbered, so a good starting point would be to number the intersections of those lines with the circular road line. That will give you 7 of the 9 GL crossings.

Next would be to look at GL43 and see where you might cross it 3 times in a row without crossing another GL in between. That leads you to GS's 0742 and 0743, and to get there from TC16 means crossing GL's 08 and then 44 (one of the un-numbered lines). So that will give you a starting point at 9 o'clock, and an anti-clockwise direction.

And you will get to the last un-numbered grid line just when you are ready to cross GL09. Bingo!
