Explanation

Novices have to work out that they have to go into the white lay-by so that they can "TL at 01805095" back on to the main road. Otherwise it is straightforward.

Experienced Experts will spot that their numbers all end in 5 or 0, and will therefore (most likely) be the points where the road crosses grid lines, measured (in multiples of 10m, just like an 8 figure map reference) up from the nearest northing when crossing an easting, or east from the nearest easting when crossing a northing. That is what it is here. Careful measuring and plotting then takes them through the lay-by, and then on to the control.

A nice little 3 mile 6 minute section on a real rally!
