### LEG 9

TC64 to TC65

#### Novice

TC 64 (184589→E) to TC 65 (203578)

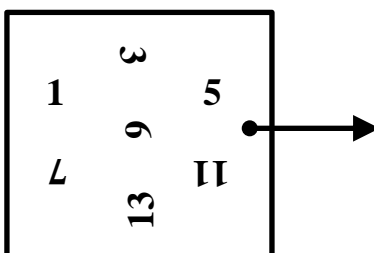

Grid square exits, in order:- E N N S E E W E S W W E S

#### Expert

TC 64 (184589→E) to TC 65

The instructions for both classes relate to the exit directions from consecutive grid squares. Novices get all 13, but the Experts only get the odd numbered ones. The Experts also have to work out the direction from the orientation of the numbering of the junctions. We saw this back in Leg 2 and if you remember that, you may also be suspicious that the 9 could be a 6, but on this occasion it is a 9.

The odd numbered junctions only mean that the Experts are always looking ahead, but for both classes it is reasonably straightforward until you are looking for the west exit from the 7<sup>th</sup> GS (2159). After entering that GS the immediate U-turn back across GL21 then leads to the required E, S and W crossings near Beechfield.

But if you don't spot the U-turn option there is a compliant route across to the other side of the GS (but not crossing GL22) and then back to the east side and around the back of the buildings at Beechfield. But that route is quite a bit longer, and therefore not correct.

Whichever way you went, by the time you are into GS 2058 you are back on the correct route and safely on the way to TC65.
