Same instruction (more or less!) for both classes, but apologies to those Experts who know those classic Porsches as “nine-one-ones” rather than “nine-elevens”. But then again, maybe nine “one-ones” works just as well!

So the obvious 11's are the grid lines and the obscured route through Boggle Hill adds a couple extra to take the count up to 4.

Then there are the spot heights. There are several which have digits which add up to 11. So you can add 4 more by including SH's 65, 92, 83 and 74 in your route.

And the final 11 is on the white north of SH92, which crosses the “11” of the contour numbering “110”.

Nine elevens. Classic.
