## **Explanation**

Balls and Arrows for the Novices. It's the usual rules, enter the junction by the ball, and exit by the arrow, with the junctions shown in the correct order.

For the Experts, numbers in a grid suggests visiting grid squares the stated number of times. The GS location for TC5 is shown, but not the one for TC4, so that is the first thing to work out. The "3" is the key. Not many GS's will have a road layout which will permit 3 separate visits. Once you have identified that one as GS0346, the others fall into place and the route can be worked out. On this occasion the grid is the correct way up. And it is not mirrored, though that was tempting!

Don't be confused by the bit of section TC7 to TC8 in the SE corner of this map.
