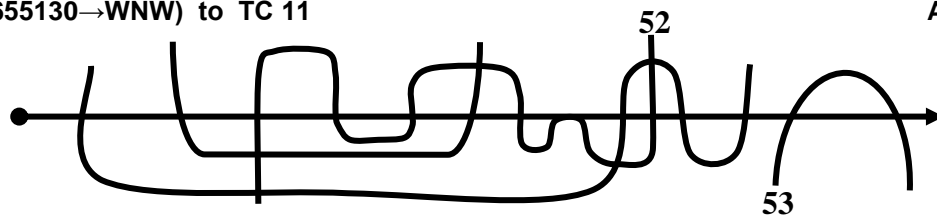
Cross the following grid lines in order:-

05 04 52 52 52 04 52 05 52 05 05 53 53

Explanation

These instructions look quite different but they are the same in many respects.

For the novices all is straightforward until the fourth 52. The eye takes you straight down the brown road to cross GL52 before turning left on to the yellow. Now looking to cross GL05, if not careful you will then turn right on to the white, and fail to spot that in doing so you have crossed GL 52 twice more – but they are not on your list. To cross GL52 only once before getting to GL05, you have to turn left on to the white in GS0452. TR at the crossroads and then TL on to the white just before GL52. The white then touches but does not cross GL52 (see the Regulations!), so all is well there. And the Regs also permit TR twice at a crossroads, which gets you back on to the yellow and on to TC11.

Experts get some spaghetti! A curvy road is shown as a straight line, and straight grid lines are shown as curvy spaghetti. Unsettling!

Two of the grid lines have been numbered which gives a good start to your GL number string. The closing GL53 twice in a row will also give you a good idea of TC11 location.

Otherwise the challenges are the same as for the Novices, and maybe even easier (if you have read the Regs!) as the white touching but not crossing GL52 is also shown.
